P The Lesson is from Paul's first letter to the Corinthian Christians, the fifteenth chapter.

Friends, let me go over the Message with you one final time—this Message that I proclaimed and that you made your own; this Message on which you took your stand and by which your life has been saved.

- (I'm assuming, now, that your belief was the real thing and not a passing fancy, that you're in this for good and holding fast.)
- P The first thing I did was place before you what was placed so emphatically before me: that the Messiah died for our sins, exactly as Scripture tells it; that he was buried;
- that he was raised from death on the third day, again exactly as Scripture says;
- P that he presented himself alive to Peter, then to his closest followers ,,,
- So whether you heard it from me or from those others, it's all the same: We spoke God's truth and you entrusted your lives.
