## **COS Council Meeting**

## **September 27, 2021**

Devotional (Sue): Spent the majority of her professional life in education. When talking about the success of a student, it is often about the scores of a student. When schools underperform, the answer oftentimes is to close them and then restart them. Destroy and rebuild is often found throughout the Bible. Destroying and rebuilding can be healthy – leaving a bad relationship, leaving a bad job, etc. COS has helped her build her relationship with Jesus Christ. The tools that COS has given her has allowed her to have a better relationship with her family. God's transformation in our lives can often be about getting rid of something and bringing something better in.

Kevin Hawkins: Gave an update on Stewardship. Reviewed the message in a book called "Abundance" by Michael Ward. Discussed reframing stewardship to make the message more relatable and achievable to members. Emphasized taking the message from a message of scarcity to one of abundance. Gave a challenge to Council members to consider becoming a matching donor to encourage the congregation to increase giving. Kevin provided Council with a written report from the Stewardship team discussing their efforts.

Pastor Fritz: Reviewed his Senior Pastor statement. The full statement is online. Bible study groups are doing really well. We have four groups that meet. Two of them have 20 + attendees. Across denominations pastors are seeing a 30/40/30 trend. 30% of the post Covid members are gone. 40% are there but at a reduced capacity. 30% are more involved than ever. Sermon series "Under Pressure" has gotten great feedback.

Pastor Miriam: Reviewed her update. Talked about how on Sunday's nearly every room on the upstairs of the church is occupied with classes. Discussed some of the classes from adult to youth that are happening each week. Preschool is up and running but the numbers are low. Introduced the idea of maybe installing charging stations for electric cars and in so doing becoming the first church in the area to do that.

Rick Burnett (Administrative items):

Ratified COS Constitution sent to Synod.
