## FIRST LESSON

📖 1 Thessalonians 3:9-13 — *Plain English Version*

📖 Today's Lesson is from Paul's first letter to the Thessalonian Christians, the third chapter.

You make us so happy that we pray to God and thank him for you. We can't thank him enough. <sup>10</sup>We are always praying to God, both in the day time and at night time, and we are strongly asking him to let us visit you again. There are still some things we need to tell you about Jesus so that you can trust him even more.

<sup>11</sup>Yes, we want God, our father, and Jesus, our leader, to help us come to you. <sup>12</sup>And we want Jesus to get you to love each other and to love other people, even more than you do now. We want you to love people just as much as we love you. <sup>13</sup>We want Jesus to make you properly good and clean inside.

You see, one day Jesus, our leader, will come back, and all his people will be with him. And then we will all meet God our father, and God will see that we are properly good and clean inside, so he will be happy with us, and he will not have to blame us for doing anything wrong.

<sup>34</sup>"But keep watch on yourselves, or your hearts will become dulled by carousing, drunkenness and the worries of everyday living, and that Day will be sprung upon you suddenly like a trap! <sup>35</sup>For it will close in on everyone, no matter where they live, throughout the whole world. <sup>36</sup>Stay alert, always praying that you will have the strength to escape all the things that will happen and to stand in the presence of the Son of Man."
