P The Gospel according to Luke, the 3rd chapter.

P John's bold message seized public attention, and many began wondering if John might himself be the Anointed One promised by God.

John the Baptist: ¹⁶I baptize you with water, but One is coming—One far more powerful than I, One whose sandals I am not worthy to untie—who will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. ¹⁷ He is coming like a farmer at harvesttime, tools in hand to separate the wheat from the chaff. He will burn the chaff with unquenchable fire, and He will gather the genuine wheat into His barn.

¹⁸He preached with many other provocative figures of speech and so conveyed God's message to the people—the time had come to rethink everything.

²¹Before John's imprisonment, when he was still ... baptizing the people in the Jordan River, Jesus also came to him to be baptized. As Jesus prayed, the heavens opened, ²² and the Holy Spirit came upon Him in a physical manifestation that resembled a dove. A voice echoed out from heaven.
