### GOSPEL: John 21:1-17

**P** The Holy Gospel according to John, the twenty-first chapter. **G Glory to you, O Lord.**

**P** After [he appeared to his followers in Jerusalem,] Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. <sup>2</sup>Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples.

READER 1: <sup>3</sup>*Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing."*

**G They said to him, "We will go with you."**

**P** They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. <sup>4</sup>Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus.

READER 2: <sup>5</sup>*Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?"*

**P** When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea. <sup>8</sup>But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards off.

<sup>9</sup>When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, and bread.

READER 2: <sup>10</sup>*Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish that you have just caught."*

**P** <sup>11</sup>So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, a hundred fifty-three of them; and though there were so many, the net was not torn.
