From Genesis 6-8: **NOAH**, oh, the places you'll GO!

Good News Translation

^{6:12}God looked at the world and saw that the people were all living evil ...God told Noah, "GO build a boat, because a flood is coming. ⁷Then GO into the boat with your whole family and the animals and birds." Then the earth was flooded, but after things dried out ^{8:15}God said to Noah, ¹⁶"GO out of the boat with your family and the birds and animals with you. GO and multiply." ¹⁸So Noah did.

From Genesis 12: **ABRAM** [before God renamed him Abraham], oh, the places you'll GO!
