SECOND LESSON: Galatians 5:13-14

☒ The New Testament lesson is from Paul’s Letter to the church in Galatia, the fifth chapter.

Rather, use your freedom to serve one another in love; that’s how freedom grows. For everything we know about God’s Word is summed up in a single sentence:

Love others as you love yourself.
