#### **READING: Exodus 1:9-2:10** from The Voice

The Old Testament reading is from Exodus, the 1st and 2nd chapters L

**Narrator:** Years after Joseph and and his family settled in Egypt, the Israelites grew in number. They grew to be so many that the Egyptians started taking notice and the Egyptians became angry! The Egyptian king, Pharoah, decided that strong measures were necessary.

**Pharaoh:** <sup>9</sup>Look! There are more Israelites than ever before, and they are growing more powerful than we are. <sup>10</sup>We need to be careful in our dealings with them. Otherwise, they may grow even greater in number, and in a time of war join forces with our enemies, fight against us, and then leave the land.

**Narrator:** <sup>11</sup> So the Egyptian authorities enslaved the Israelites and appointed cruel slave drivers over them to oppress them with hard, back-breaking labor. <sup>12</sup> But the harder the slave drivers pushed the Israelites, the more rapidly they had children and spread through-

<sup>12</sup> But the harder the slave drivers pushed the Israelites, the more rapidly they had children and spread throughout the land. Because of this, the Egyptians grew to hate the Israelites even more <sup>13</sup> and violently forced them to work to make the Hebrews miserable.

<sup>15</sup> Finally, Pharaoh came up with a plan.

**Pharaoh:** <sup>16</sup> Listen closely. I do not want there to be any more Israelite boys or else they will grow up and fight me! Every boy who is born to the Hebrews must be thrown into the Nile, and every girl is to be left alive. **Narrator:** One day a man and woman from the Hebrew tribe of Levi got married. <sup>2</sup> She became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When the mother saw that her son was healthy and beautiful, she feared for his safety; so she kept him hidden from view for three whole months.

<sup>3</sup> When she could no longer keep her boy baby hidden away, she took a basket made of reeds, sealed it with tar and pitch, and placed her baby boy in it. Then she wedged the basket among the reeds along the edge of the Nile River. <sup>4</sup> All the while, the child's sister, whose name was Miriam, watched from a distance to see what might happen to her baby brother.

<sup>5</sup> Later on Pharaoh's daughter came down to bathe in the river while her young attendants walked along the bank nearby. Pharaoh's daughter noticed the basket wedged among the reeds and wondered what it might contain. She instructed her maid to bring the basket to her. <sup>6</sup> When Pharaoh's daughter opened the basket, she found the baby boy. He was crying, and her heart melted with compassion.

Pharaoh's Daughter: This is a Hebrew child! What a beautiful baby boy he is!

Narrator: Then the baby's sister, Miriam, came out of her hiding place.

Miriam: Would you like me to find a Hebrew woman to nurse the child for you?

Pharaoh's Daughter: All right. Yes! Go find a nurse!

Narrator: So, the baby's sister went and fetched the baby's own mother to be the nurse.

Pharaoh's Daughter (to the nurse): <sup>9</sup> Here! Take this child and nurse him for me, and I will pay you for your services.

**Narrator:** So, the woman took the child—who was secretly her own son—and nursed him just as Pharaoh's daughter had instructed.

<sup>10</sup> The boy grew, and when the time was right, the woman brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and she adopted him as her own. She named him Moses because, as she explained, "I took him out of the water."
