☒ The Old Testament reading is from Isaiah, the 25th chapter.

On this mountain the Lord of hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wines, of rich food filled with marrow, of well-aged wines strained clear. ⁷And he will destroy on this mountain the shroud that is cast over all peoples, the sheet that is spread over all nations; ⁸he will swallow up death forever. Then the Lord God will wipe away the tears from all faces, and the disgrace of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the Lord has spoken.

⁹It will be said on that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, so that he might save us. This is the Lord for whom we have waited; let us be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

**SECOND LESSON: Romans 6:3-4; Galatians 3:27-28;
Colossians 3:9-15; 2 Corinthians 5:2-4;
1 Corinthians 15:53-54, and Philippians 4:8**

☒ The New Testament reading is selected verses from Romans, Galatians, Colossians, 2nd Corinthians, 1st Corinthians and Philippians.*

ROM 6:3 Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

⁴Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.

GAL 3:27 As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

COL 3:9b ...you have stripped off the old self with its practices ¹⁰and have clothed yourselves with the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge according to the image of its creator.



*INTRODUCTION TO THE 2nd LESSON(S): "Clothed in Christ," what does this mean?

To the churches in Rome, Galatia, Colossae, Philippi, and Corinth, St. Paul describes the newness we have in baptism – that in our baptism into Christ, we have clothed ourselves with Christ, therefore, we walk in newness of life. What does that mean? The following verses offer us insight: Romans 6:3-4; Galatians 3:28; Colossians 3:9-15; 2 Corinthians 5:2-4; 1 Corinthians 15:53-54, and Philippians 4:8, All passages are from the New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition.

GAL 3:28 There is no longer Jew or Greek; there is no longer slave or free; there is no longer male and female, for we are all one in Christ Jesus.

COL 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. ¹³Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. ¹⁴Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. ¹⁵And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.

2 COR 5:2 For in this tent we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling — ³if indeed, when we have taken it off we will not be found naked. ⁴For while we are still in this tent, we groan under our burden, because we wish not to be unclothed but to be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.

1 COR 15:53 For this perishable body must put on imperishability, and this mortal body must put on immortality. ⁵⁴When this perishable body puts on imperishability, and this mortal body puts on immortality, then the saying that is written will be fulfilled: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

PHIL 4:8 Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

Once more Jesus spoke to them in parables, saying:

²“The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son. ³He sent his slaves to call those who had been invited to the wedding banquet, but they would not come. ⁴Again he sent other slaves, saying, ‘Tell those who have been invited: Look, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready; come to the wedding banquet.’

⁵But they made light of it and went away, one to his farm, another to his business, ⁶while the rest seized his slaves, mistreated them, and killed them. ⁷The king was enraged. He sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. ⁸Then he said to his slaves, ‘The wedding is ready, but those invited were not worthy. ⁹Go therefore into the main streets, and invite everyone you find to the wedding banquet.’ ▶

¹⁰Those slaves went out into the streets and gathered all whom they found, both good and bad; so the wedding hall was filled with guests. ¹¹“But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing a wedding robe, ¹²and he said to him, ‘Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding robe?’ And he was speechless. ¹³Then the king said to the attendants, ‘Bind him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’ ¹⁴For many are called, but few are chosen.”
