FIRST READING: 1 Kings 6:1-2, 7, 18-20, 23, 28-32, 37

The first reading is from 1st Kings, the 6th chapter.

¹In the four hundred eightieth year after the Israelites came out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month of Ziv, which is the second month, Solomon began to build the house of the LORD.² The house that King Solomon built for the LORD was sixty cubits long, twenty cubits wide, and thirty cubits high.

⁷ The house was built with stone finished at the quarry so that neither hammer nor ax nor any tool of iron was heard in the temple while it was being built.

¹⁸ The cedar within the house had carvings of gourds and open flowers; all was cedar; no stone was seen. ¹⁹ The inner sanctuary he prepared in the innermost part of the house, to set there the ark of the covenant of the LORD.²⁰ The interior of the inner sanctuary was twenty cubits long, twenty cubits wide, and twenty cubits high; he overlaid it with pure gold. He also overlaid the altar with cedar.

 23 In the inner sanctuary he made two cherubim of olivewood, each ten cubits high . . . it was ten cubits from the tip of one wing to the tip of the other. 28 He also overlaid the cherubim with gold.

²⁹ He carved the walls of the house all around about with carved engravings of cherubim, palm trees, and open flowers, in the inner and outer rooms.³⁰ The floor of the house he overlaid with gold, in the inner and outer rooms.

³¹ For the entrance to the inner sanctuary he made doors of olivewood; the lintel and the doorposts were five-sided. ³² He covered the two doors of olivewood with carvings of cherubim, palm trees, and open flowers: he overlaid them with gold and spread gold on the cherubim and on the palm trees.

³⁷ The house was finished in all its parts and according to all its specifications. Solomon was seven years in building it.

Then the fever left her, and she began to serve them. ³²That evening, at sunset, they brought to him all who were sick or possessed with de-mons. ³³And the whole city was gathered around the door. ³⁴And he cured many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him. ³⁵In the morning, while it was still very dark, he got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. ³⁶And Simon and his companions hunted for him. ³⁷When they found him, they said to him, "Everyone is searching for you." ³⁸He answered, "Let us go on to the neighboring towns, so that I may proclaim the message there also; for that is what I came out to do." ³⁹And he went throughout Galilee, proclaiming the message in their synagogues and casting out demons.
