FIRST READING Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14

L The first reading is from Daniel, the 7th chapter. ⁹As I watched. thrones were set in place, and an Ancient One took his throne. his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames, and its wheels were burning fire. ¹⁰A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence.
