READING: Selected Verses from the New Testament

■ Today's reading is selected verses from the New Testament.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-11

⁹For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁰who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. ¹¹Therefore **encourage one another and build up each other,** as indeed you are doing.

Romans 15:1-6

We who are strong ought to put up with the failings of the weak and not to please ourselves. ²Each of us must please our neighbor for the good purpose of building up the neighbor. ³For Christ did not please himself, but, as it is written, "The insults of those who insult you have fallen on me." ⁴For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and by the encouragement of the scriptures we might have hope. ⁵May the God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another, in accordance with Christ Jesus, ⁶so that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 10:19-25

¹⁹Therefore, my brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the sanctuary by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain (that is, through his flesh), ²¹and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²²let us approach with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. ²³Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful. ²⁴And let us consider how to **provoke one another to love and good deeds,** ²⁵not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, **but encouraging one another,** and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

GOSPEL: John 14:1-20 selected verses

P The Holy Gospel according to John, the 14th chapter. Glory to you, O Lord.

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. ²In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. . . . ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also. . . . ⁷If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him." . . ¹²Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father. ¹³I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. . . . ¹⁶And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. ¹⁷This is the Spirit of truth, . . . you know him because he abides with you, and he will be in you. . . because I live, you also will live. ²⁰On that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.
