

# Congregational Meeting Minutes

Sunday May 18, 2025

Pastor Wes offered a prayer.

Bill Grabill:

1. Announced a quorum has been met and called the meeting to order at 12:35
2. Approval of January Minutes: Congregant moved, another second, motion to approve minutes passed.
3. Motion by Bill Grabill as follows:

**"Whereas the Call to Action Account established in 2004-2007 has largely met its original purpose and; whereas there remains approximately \$89,000 in the Call to Action account as of May 1, 2025;**

**Therefore any remaining funds in the Call to Action account on May 19, 2025 shall be transferred to the Property & Facility reserved account to be used for maintenance or upgrades at 101 Peachtree Parkway and/or 411 Palmetto Road.**

4. Discussions ensued on purpose and utilization of CTA funds: Peachtree City property versus Palmetto or both.
5. Motion was made by Sue Byers to amend the original motion to allocate said funds to PTC only. Motion was seconded. Motion overwhelmingly denied (4 yays, 70+ nays).
6. The original motion was then voted on and passed overwhelmingly by voice vote.

Budget Revision and Approval: Mark Bunker

1. Revise 2025 budget: Mark goes over slides showing why we need to revise due to new ERTC funds. Discussions ensued for a short time. Motion made, seconded and passed.
2. Approval of 2026 budget: Mark goes into great detail of each facet of the proposed budget with slides on each section and offers discussion/questions of each before moving on.

6. Discussion regarding costs, committee and implementing an outside source for completing necessary Audit.
  7. Motion was made and seconded to pass the 2026 proposed budget seconded, Congregation approved (no nays).

Concluding Remarks: Bill thanked the congregation for staying and for the discussions held. He also thanked the people who found the available ERTC funds that helped ease the budget for both 2025 and 2026. Bill also thanked the finance committee for all their diligence and hard work in completing both budgets.

At 1:08 Bill moved the meeting to be adjourned. Motion, seconded and passed by the congregation. A prayer followed immediately by Pastor Fritz. After announcements the meeting ended at 1:10 PM.

During the meeting Bill announced the election of the new Youth Representative to Council: Hope. We look forward to seeing her at future council meetings.
